

Annual Athletic Meet 2011 in The Asian School

12th Annual Athletic Meet 2011 of The Asian School drew to a close here on 21st October 2011 at the Woods with the Chief Guest Hon'ble Suryakant Dhasmana, closing the annual sports extravaganza. At the close of the meet Shivaji House with a tally of 188.33 points stood I followed by the Arjun House with 177.67 points, which stood II. Ranjit House with 171.99 points stood III. The Final Day saw 24 field events all very keenly contested with all the four houses vying with each other to add to the final tally. The final day of the meet began with 100m Hurdles for Boys Above 14 with Pariwat (Ranjit House) standing first clocking 13.55 secs. Mayank Sharma with a close 13.93 secs stood 2nd and Joy Deep (Arjun House) stood third with a timing of 13.96 secs stood III. Whereas Shailja Thakur was adjudged the Best Athlete among the girls, Saalim Shamsi was adjudged the Best Athlete among the boys. In the Pre KG Balloon Bursting Race, Kevin Arora bagged the I position and in Threading the Bead Race for LKG Trisha Singh Stood I. 25m Run for Class I Boys was won by Hitesh.





The 12th Annual Athletic Meet 2011, spread over 05 days, saw the Asianites participate in a host of track and field events. In the 800m Run Open Girls, Shailja Thakur (Arjun House) bagged the first position, and in the 100m Run Boys Under 12 Krishan Kant (Ranjit House), who bagged the I position, was followed by Saurabh Pal (Shivaji House) and Aditya Somya (Shivaji House) occupying II and III positions respectively. In the Long Jump Under 12 Girls Chetna Kumari (Arjun House) bagged the I position, Nicole Sangma (Ranjit House) stood II, and Rashi Jain (Shivaji House) had to remain contented with a III position. In the Discus Throw for Boys Above 14, Shiv Ganga (Ashoka House) took the lead followed by Ankit Nowal (Shivaji House). In the most awaited final of 100m Run for Boys Above 14, Ashish Thapa (Arjun House) emerged as the Fastest Boy, clocking 10.87 secs, and bagged a Gold medal for this feat, whereas Anmol Gautam (Ashoka House) stood II. The long Jump for Girls Above 14, Shelja Thakur (Arjun House) once again proved her mettle and bagged the I position; Himadri Chand (Shivaji House) and Tanushree Nagi (Ashoka House) occupied the II and III positions respectively.

In the 4 × 100m Relay for Boys Above 14, the House positions were as follows: I Ranjit, II Arjun, III Ashoka. The 200m Run for Boys Above 14 saw Anmol Gautam (Ashoka) bag I position whereas Shaban Ali (Arjun House) was placed II. Ankit Nowal (Shivaji House) once again proved to be a better contender in Javelin

Throw for Boys Above 14 when he led Shiv Ganga (Ashoka House) and Asif Siddiqui (Arjun House) and bagged a Gold medal. The performances put in by Pagorn Dungkong in the 200m Run for Boys Under 14 and of Sheikh Wajiha in 100m Run for Girls Under 14 were equally praiseworthy.

In the most awaited track event of the 4x400 m relay for boys above 14, Arjun House with a timing of 4:25:50 secs outpaced the Ranjit House which clocked 4:31:62 secs. With a timing of 4:34:10 secs, Ashoka House occupied the III position on the victory stand.

A perfect coordination in Yoga display by Jr and Middle school students was very well received by the guests. Speaking on the occasion Hon'ble Chief Guest Suryakant Dhasmana felt honoured in having been invited to grace the 12th Annual Athletic Meet. He also observed that the function and the events brought his school days afresh to his mind. He advised the students to live life to the fullest as the time that has once passed cannot be ever reclaimed.
