

Sardarni Kawaljeet Juneja Staff Student Cup

The Asian Challengers once again pulled off an amazing victory and took away the Sardarni Kawaljeet Juneja Staff Student Cup here at the Abhimanyu Cricket Ground, Guniyal Gaon on 9th April 2011 – the setting for The Day Night Contest which commenced with staff electing to bat and, as on earlier such occasions, with the Sheet Anchor's role by the veteran Mr Brijesh Paliwal, who eventually retired exhausted, set a target of 107 in 20 overs for the students.

Playing in the flood lit ACA Ground later on in the evening, the students put on display the characteristic finesse of the burgeoning cricketers but many of the shots off the bats of many staff members were equally beautifully executed; these copy book shots, as also elegant fielding, added to the beauty of the picturesque ACA Ground nestled in verdant Guniyal Gaon. For many present this keenly contested Day Night match would have been the first experience of its kind. With 97 for 6 wickets at the end of 17th over, the target of 107 looked well within reach of students. Although at no point of time during the course of their batting, did the students look a wee bit uncomfortable despite squandering a few wickets by dropping catches, the tenacity put up by the staff was commendable.

For his batting prowess as also commendable performance on field Aryaman Sethi was adjudged Man of the Match; Aman Saxena was the Best Bowler with a decent haul of 2 wickets. Mr Brijesh Paliwal deservedly took away Best Batsmam award.
