

Annual Prize Giving Ceremony, The Asian School, Dehradun

The 17th Annual Prize Giving Ceremony was held on May 18, 2018 at the White House Court of The Asian School, Dehradun. A large number of Asianites received awards as a mark of recognition for maintaining consistency in achieving excellence in academics in all examinations. A distinctive criterion has been devised in the school to enlist the students who have secured 90% marks in three subjects out of six subjects. The school also gives commendation awards to students who are otherwise weak and have shown consistent improvement in the year in their academic achievements.
