ENGLISH

MATHEMATICS

- HANDS ON ACTIVITY Prove that the sum of all the exterior angles of a polygon is 360° by paper cutting and pasting method using cut-outs of colourful papers.
 Prove for at least three different polygons e.g. triangle, quadrilateral, pentagon etc. (Refer to PDF and video shared in class group)
- 2. Measure the dimensions of your study room and calculate its total surface area.
- 3. Using chart paper make a cube of each side 10 cm. Find its volume. Measure its capacity in litres.
- 4. Prepare for Numerical ability test (to be conducted in January).
- 5. Learn squares of numbers 1 to 30, cubes of numbers 1 to 15 and multiplication tables 2 to 20.

SCIENCE

Find out about a few lifestyle related diseases or health problems commonly occurring nowadays. Create a survey form on *Google Forms* focusing on the various health issues/diseases/health problems being faced nowadays due to changing lifestyle, use of particular devices/gadgets. You may include questions regarding number of persons in the family suffering from a particular disease, precautions or steps being taken for that disorder/health issue, any course of treatment being taken and the cause they think is responsible for it.

Distribute the survey to at least TEN families. Include at least TEN questions in the survey. From the results obtained, prepare a report on an A4 sheet. Do paste relevant pictures, graphs etc.
