- Keep their surroundings neat and tidy

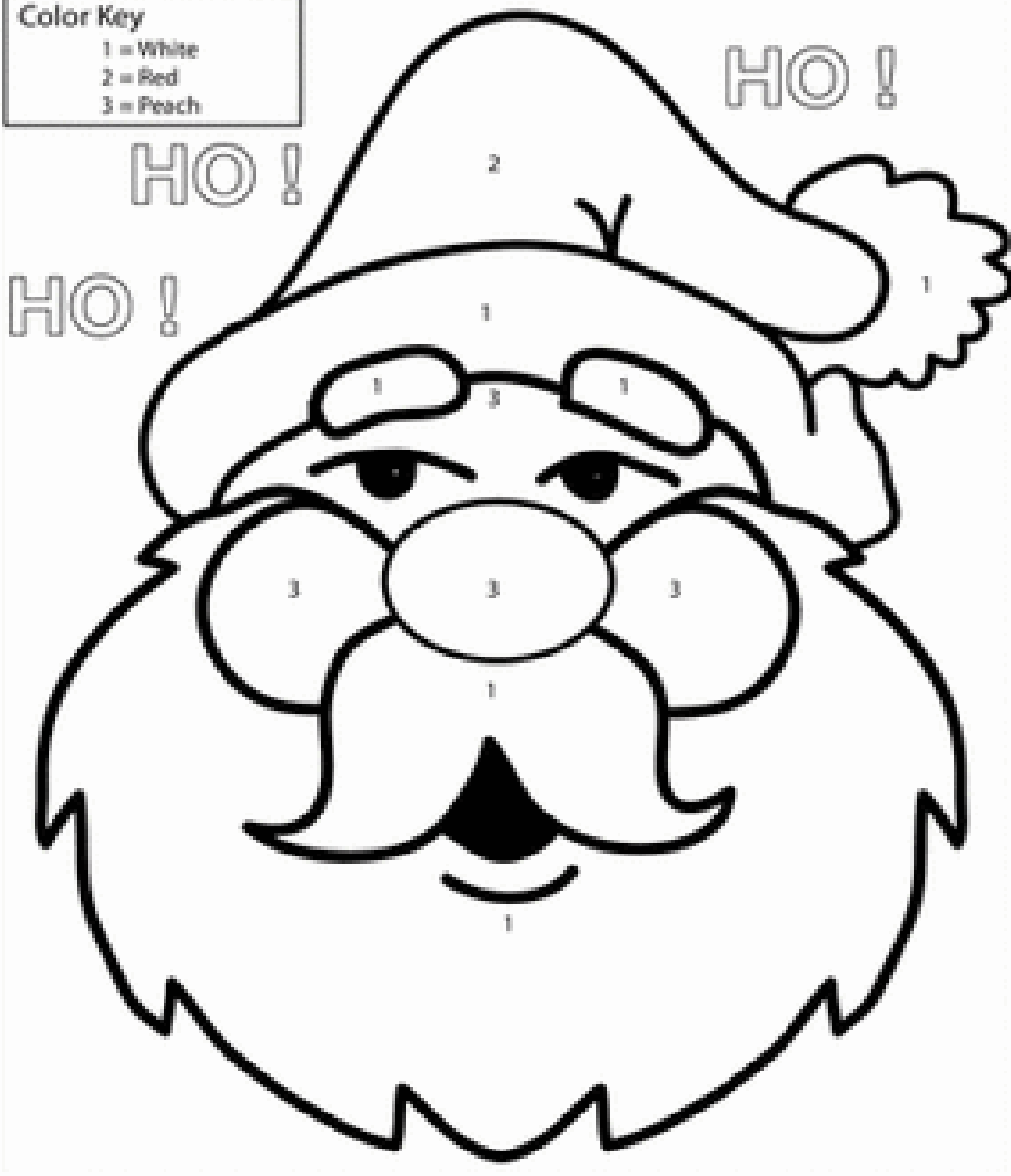

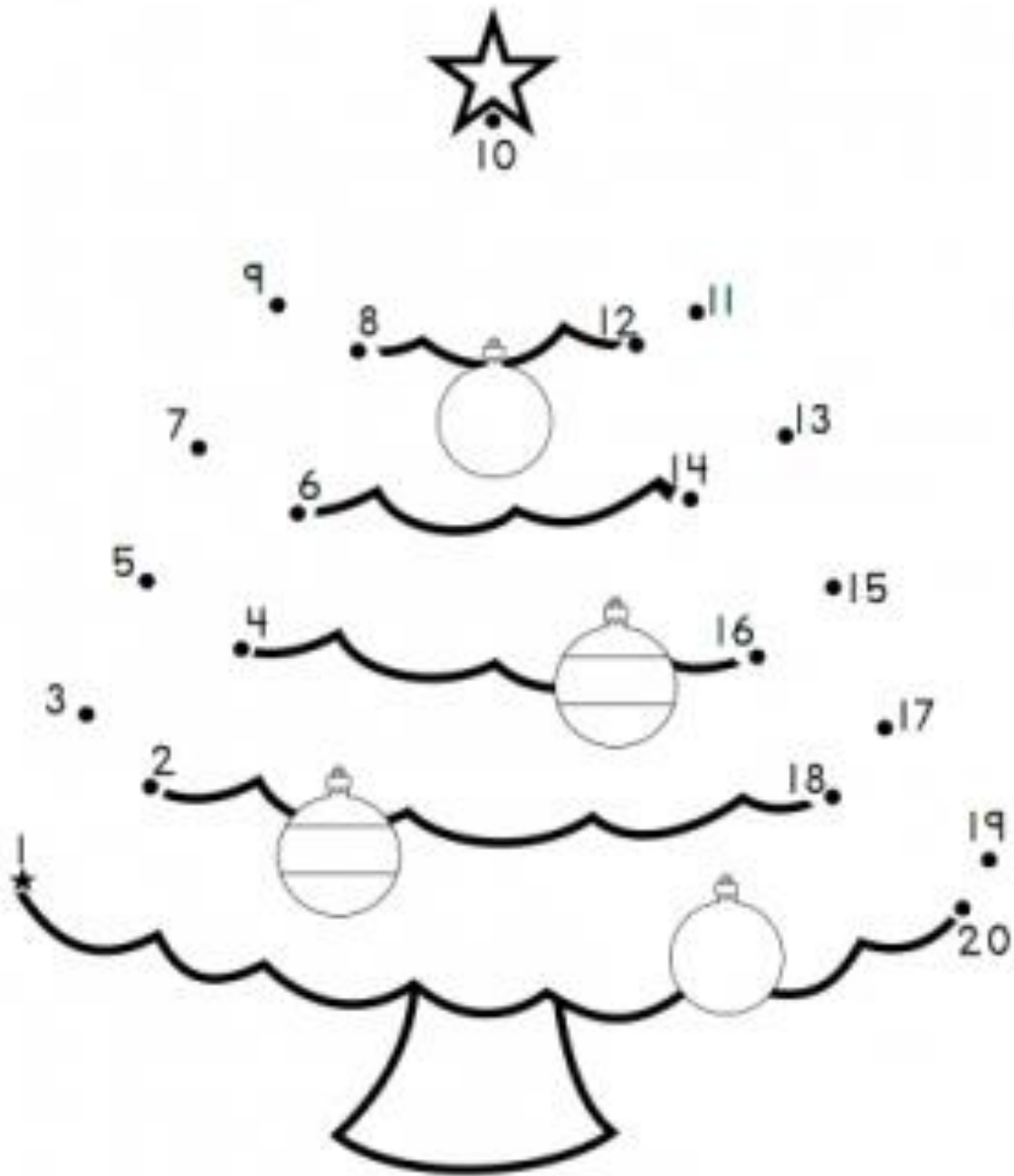
Color Key
