

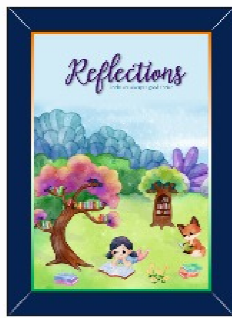

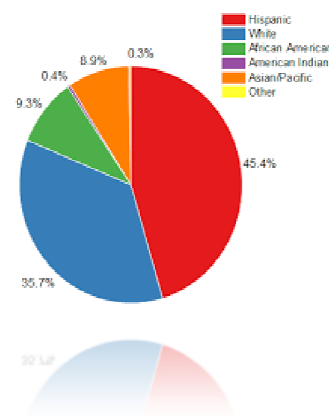
- पुस्तिका को सुंदर चित्रों, रंगों और सजावट से आकर्षक बनाएं।

- **Cultural Heritage** (festivals, traditional dress, art)
- **Language and Religion** (languages spoken, major religions)
- **Tourist Attractions** (beaches temples etc.)

Include maps, pictures, and short descriptions. Make it colourful and presentable.



6. COMPUTER SCIENCE

Computer – Computer homework will focus on your ability to present and organize the work you have compiled for all subjects.

The final holiday homework file will be evaluated based on its overall presentation, including:

- Neatness and formatting
- Proper arrangement of subject-wise content

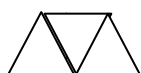
