





- 2. Members of the United Nations

Suggestions for Presentation:

- Cover page with your name, class, and school
- Decorate with:
 - UN logo
 - World map showing member countries
 - Drawings/symbols of UN agencies like UNICEF, WHO, UNESCO
- Use coloured headings and short descriptions
- Include at least 2–3 pictures (e.g., UN Peacekeepers, UN meetings)
