

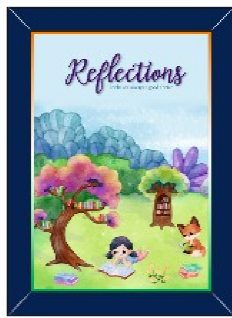

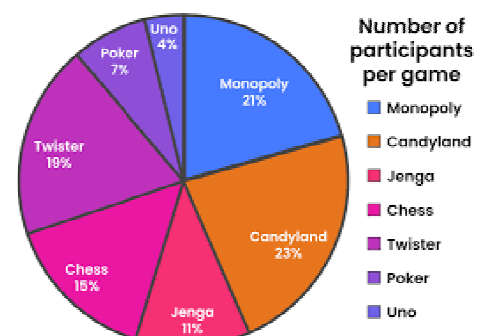


3. MATHEMATICS

Your file should include:

- **Introduction** to the UN

- Use **colored headings**, maps, UN logos, and related pictures
- Add a **cover page** with your name, class, and school

You can use pictures of:

- UN peacekeepers
- UNICEF/WHO work
- UN flag, symbols, and agencies



6. COMPUTER SCIENCE

Computer – Computer homework will focus on your ability to present and organize the work you have compiled for all subjects.

The final holiday homework file will be evaluated based on its overall presentation, including:
