SCIENCE :

Your project file must include the following points:

Introduction – What is separation of substances and why is it needed?

- Different Methods of Separation (explain each with aim, process, importance & examples):

Handpicking, Winnowing, Sieving, Sedimentation & Decantation, Filtration, Evaporation, Threshing, Magnetic Separation.

Activity – Based on Daily-life for each method (e.g., tea filtration, grain cleaning, etc.)

Instructions: - Students to mention the materials used and stepwise Process along with related Pictures/Diagrams.

- Importance of separation in daily life.
- Soluble and insoluble substances

➤ Activity: Prepare a simple filtration setup at home and write observations.

 8. Bibliography

Write 10 synonyms and Write 10 antonyms.

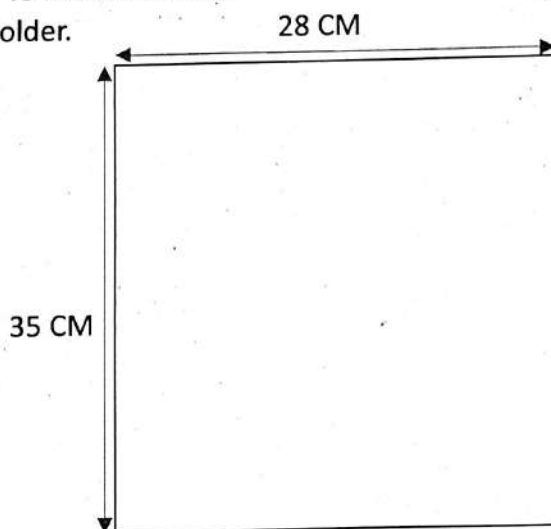
